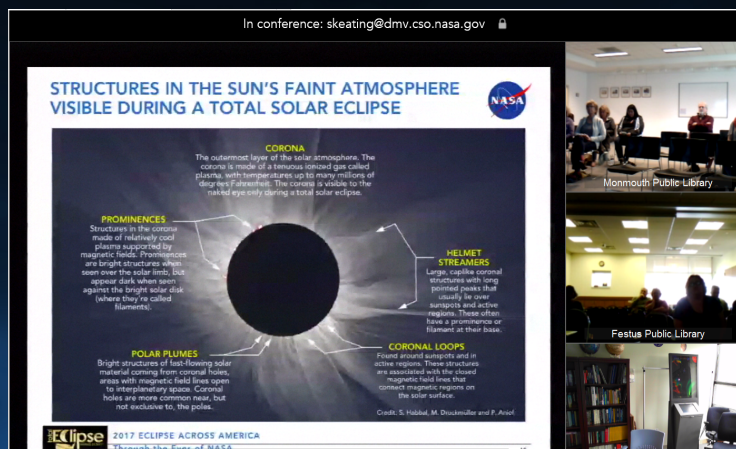




Live Virtual Eclipse Presentation for *NASA@ My Library* Communities
