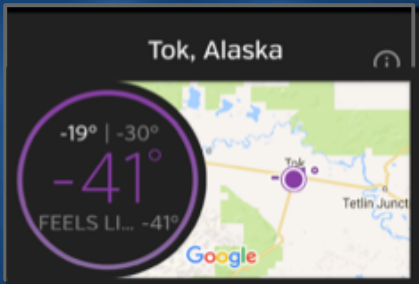

Workshop activities emphasized using models to understand the impacts and feedbacks of a warming Arctic. Teachers even braved the cold to use the GLOBE Observer Cloud App to help NASA improve models of the Earth's energy balance.
